Paper size: A4

Margins: 2,5 cm on each sides

Font type: Calibri, 12 pts

Line spacing: single, before and after paragraph: 0 pts

Language: English

Title of the presentation: Bold, left aligned

- one empty line -

Authors: Italic, left aligned, separated by commas. If the authors have different affiliations, indexed Affiliation, Country: Italic, left aligned, separated by new lines, index numbers placed at the beginning of the line

- one empty line -

Abstract text: Normal, justified, paragraphs without indentations

Title must not exceed 250 characters, spaces included.

Abstracts must **at least and not exceed 300 words in length excluding title, authors and affiliations**.

Please make sure that no references, tables and/or figures are presented in the abstract.

Abstracts will include a clear statement of the purpose of the work, the methods used, the results, and the author's discussion and conclusions. Results should be presented and discussed in sufficient detail to support conclusions drawn. In case of use of specific acronyms, they will be explained the first time that are used. Abstracts not supported by data will be rejected.

Save as .doc, .docx or .rtf file, with the file name of the presenting author (e.g.: Kukovics.doc).

Example:

The sustainable goat farming in the Central and East European regions

The structure of the full paper should be as follows:

Abstract

Introduction

Material and methods

Results and discussions

Conclusions

References (It should not be more than 5)

References in the text should be as follows: (Gipsz et al, 2021); or (Gipsz, 2021.)

The length of whole paper would be maximum 6 pages in A4 size for Regional Directors, and maximum 4 pages in A4 size for Country Representatives.
